Nakong eo makgotla a hajwale a metse a ntseng a itokisetsa ho phethela mesebetsi ya bona le ho qetella nako e behilweng ya dilemo tse hlano ya makgotla a metse e fihlang pheletsong ka Mphalane monongwaha, Lekgotla la Motse la Metsimaholo le phatlaladitse ditekanyetsong tsa tjhelete tsa R1,6 bilione bakeng sa selemo sa 2021/2022 sa ditjhelete. Nakong eo a neng a teka ditekanyetsong tsena tsa ditjhelete kopanong ya Lekgotla la Motse e neng e tshwaretswe Sasolburg, Majoro wa Phethahatso wa Metsimaholo Lindiwe Tshongwe o tsebisitse hore Masepala e lebeletse lekeno la R1,633 billion athe haele tjhelete e tla sebediswa yona e tla fihla ho R1,5 billion.

Tjhelete ya diprojeke yona e nyolohile ho tloha ho R233.3 million ka 2020/2021 ho ya ho R259 million ka selemo se tleng sa ditjhelete sa 2021/2022.

Majoro o hhalosits e hore motlakase le metsi ke yona mehlodi e ka sehloholong lekenong la ditjhelete tsa masepala. Motlakase o etsa 21% ya lekeno mme metsi wona a etsa 31% ya lekeno. Haele thepa ya meaho yona e kenya 13%

lekenong la masepala. Diprojeke tse masepala o ikemiseditseng ho sebetsana le tsona selemong se setjha sa ditjhelete di kenyededitse theko ya sebaka seo ho lahlelwang matlakala ho sona, ho kenya dimitara tsa metsi ditsheng tse 2 537 tse Themba Kubeka ka Refengkgotso, ho kenya dipeipi tse ntjha tsa phepelo ya metsi ka Zamdela, ho lokisa ditsela, ho ntlafatsa setsha sa bafu se Zamdela le ho hokela motlakase matlong a fapaneng kahare ho Masepala.

Majoro o boetse a ntsha maikutlo a ho nyahama ka baka la ditlamorao tsa Covid-19. O boletse hore sewa sa Covid-19 se tswela pele ho ba le kgahlamelo e mpe ditshebeletsong tsa bophelo le maemong a moruo wa Masepala.

"Batho ba bangata kahare ho Metsimaholo ba felletswe ke mesebetsi. Dikgwebo di ile tsa qobellwa ho kwala mme re le setjhaba sa Metsimaholo re tlameha ho dula re le karolo ya ntwa kgahlano le Covid-19. "Re ntse re le kahara sewa sena hape le leqhubu la boraro ke lena le kene kahara profensi ya rona. Sena se bolela hore ha re ya tlameha ho iketla le ho itlohella feela," ho rialo Tshongwe.

O tswetse pele ka le reng haesale lekgotla la hajwale la motse le kena pusong e tshwerweng ke mekga e fapaneng ya dipolitiki ho na le matshwao le sesupo sa maikemisetso a Masepala a ho ntlafatsa mapheho a baahi. Hara tsona ho kenyededitse ho lokiswa ha mmila wa metara tse pedi kahare Ward 3 Refengkgotso, ntlafatsa ya setsi sa tlhwekiso ya metsi se Ward 5 Orangeville, ho kengwua ha mabone a seterateng a 13 le ntlafatsa ya pompelo ya dikgwerekwre

ka Amelia, ntlafatsa ya peipi tsa metsi Ward 11 Zamdela le ho hokelwa ha motlakase matlong a 50 a Ward 10 Somers post, Zamdela.

Tshongwe o ekeditse ka hore Masepala wa habo o kgonne le ho lefella batho ba batjha ba 60 boingodiso dibakeng tse fapaneng tsa thuto e phahameng mme lefile tjhelete ya boleng ba R500 000 – 00 ka lenaneo la Nthute Mayoral Tertiary Funding.

Majoro o ntse boipiletso ho baahi bao lekeno la bona e leng R5 280 le ka tlase ho ingodisa lenaneng la baahi ba kojwana di mahetleng e tle e le hore ba tsebe ho una lenaneo la ditshebeletso tsa mantlha tsa mahala.

"Ha jwale lenaneo la rona la dithuso ka ditshebeletso tsa mantlha le tshehedits malapa a fetang 13 000 ka metsi a mahala a 6 kilolitre, motlakase wa mahala wa 50 killowatt, tlhwekiso ya dikgwerekwre ya mahala le ho thothwa ha matlakala ha mahala ekasitana le tshehetso ya R50 bakeng sa ditefello tsa thepa ya meaho," ho

rialo Majoro.

O bolela hore ditekanyetsong tsa ditjhelete tsa 2021/2022 ke sesupo sa maikemisetso a Masepala a ho ntlafatsa mapheho a baahi ba Metsimaholo le ho Iwantshana le bofuma kahohle-hohle.
