tsona haholo ka tshebediso ya marang-rang ho rera Evangedi le ho buisana le maphutheho a bona. Mongodi Kakaretso wa Council of African Independent Churches (CAIC), Bishop TS Ngcana, o boletse hore bohloko ba Coronavirus bo hlahile dikereke lesumatha ho se mang ya neng a lebeletse hore ho ka etsahala sena se etsahetseng mme ha ho moruti kapa kereke e bile le nako ya ho ithlopha hantle. CAIC ke mekgatlo wa dikereke tse 351 o thehilweng ka 1982. "Dikereke ha di a sitiseha feela mekgweng wa tsona wa ho kopanela-mmoho kamehla empa le nakong ya Paseka ebile tshitiso e kgolo. Ebile Paseka e bodutu eo re sa e tlwaelang. Empa ka lehlakoreng le leng, dikereke di kgonne ho tla le mekgwa e metjha ya ho tshwara ditshebeletso ka ho sebedisa social media, ekasitana le nakong ya Paseka. Ngcana o boletse hore ha jwale maemo ana a renang ha a so ame ha bohloko maemo a ditjhelete tsa maphutheho a bona empa ha a ka nna a tswella ho ya pele a tla qala ho ba thefula. Moruti Thabiso Mashiloane wa kereke ya City of Love and Restoration e motseng wa Zamdela, Sasolburg, o dumellana le se buwang ke Ngcana ka hore mathata a Coronavirus a na le bobbe le botle kahare. "Ditjheleteng teng re amehile ha bohloko

empa leha ho le jwalo re ntse re e na le lehlohonolo leo la hore tse ding tsa ditho tsa rona tse tshepahalang di ntse di ntsha menhelo ka ho e kenya ka ho otloha akhaontong ya kereke mme re rata ho ba leboha ka diatla tsa bona tseo ba re buletseng tsona," ho boletse Mashiloane. O boletse hore tshebediso ya marang-rang a social media e kgonne ho fa kereke ya hae monyetla wa ho fihlela batho ba ka hodimo ho dikete tse tharo (3 000) tsebeletso kang. "Monyetla o mong ke wa hore batho ba ka kgona ho shebella dithero ka nako e nngwe le enngwe e seng nakong ya tsebeletso fela," ho rialo Mashiloane.

When God is trying to tell you something.. 1 Samuel 3: 1 – 10

There are many ways through which God speaks to His children. It is thus important for you to discern and realize as a child of God when your Father is trying to tell you something. Through the preaching, through the confirmation of some of the things in your life, through the incidents that are happening in your life, through the scenes that are repeating themselves in your life, the prophecies, the dreams and the visions, the repetition of the same verses.....all these are signs that God is trying to tell you something. In Exodus 3: 2 – 6, when He wanted to tell Moses something, he appeared in a burning bush. In the garden of Eden, He appeared as a

walking voice when He wanted to tell Adam something. Genesis 3:8
He appeared in a whirlwind when He wanted to tell Job something. Job 38: 1
He appeared in the stillness of the voice when He wanted to tell Elijah something. 1 Kings 19: 11 – 13
He appeared as an ordinary human being to the men who were on the road to Emmaus. Luke 24: 13 – 35
He was trying to tell Peter something when he showed a vision of all kinds of animals and told him to kill and eat. Acts 10: 9 – 16 / Acts 11: 1 – 18
In all these scenarios, God drew the attention of all the people He wanted to tell them something in a particular way: the burning bush, the walking voice, whirlwind, still voice, an ordinary human being, all sorts of animals, a vision.
When God is about to tell you something, He will:

- Draw your attention in a particular way

- Make His voice audible
- Confirm what you have been told or heard

- Speak direct to your heart
- Give you peace in your heart. In the midst of your struggles, pain, tears and sorrow you will experience the peace that you have never experience before.

Give you joy that you have never felt before
