Three suspects including exgirlfriend arrested for alleged murder of Vanderbijlpark couple



The police have arrested three suspects including an ex-girlfriend for the alleged murder of a 35-year-old man and his 29-year-old pregnant partner. The suspects, aged between 30 and 32 are facing three counts of murder, kidnapping and house robbery among other possible additional charges.

The couple was reported missing on the 15 December 2022 in Vanderbijlpark. Various units of the police that include Crime Intelligence, Hawks, Gauteng Provincial Investigation Unit, Sedibeng K9, SAPS Vanderbijlpark and SAPS Heidelberg were mobilized to search for the victims.

A thorough search and investigation led to the arrest of three suspects in Heidelberg and the discovery of the bodies in an open field in Heidelberg on Friday, 23 December 2022.

The suspects appeared before Heidelberg Magistrates' Court on Wednesday, 28 December 2022.



40-year-old suspect arrested with a large quantity of drugs in Standerton



A major breakthrough was achieved when an operation conducted by Standerton Crime Intelligence and Ermelo K9 led to the arrest of a 40-year-old suspect who was driving a vehicle with a large quantity of drugs in Standerton on Thursday 05 January 2023.

The suspect who is also known as a motor mechanic's residence was visited in Meyerville, Standerton where police further recovered a stripped blue Toyota Etios which on investigation it was discovered that the vehicle was reported stolen at Wierdabrug in 2020. The team proceeded to Volkrust where a 43-year-old suspect was arrested with nine stones of unpacked cat (372 grams) to the estimated street value of R18 000-00.
