



The Free State Arts and Culture Council (FSACC) and the Department of Sport, Arts and Culture (DSAC) invite applications for arts practitioners to participate in Artists in Schools Programme (AiS). Forty (20) arts practitioners must be deployed in 20 schools across the province. Five (5) practitioners per district and balancing gender, disability and genres.

In order to be selected in this Programme you must meet the following criteria:

- Competent and proficient in any artistic genre across all the spectrum
- Matric and Post-Matric qualifications in the arts are emphasised but recognition of prior learning is acknowledged
- Must be able to communicate in English (medium of instruction in the schools) and vernacular of the region
- Must be adaptive and be prepared to step out of the “traditional artistic comfort zones”.
- Must have passion for learning and working with the learners

In addition to the above the following documents must accompany the application:

- (a) Letter from the school with school stamp signed by the principal
- (b) Copy of ID of applicant
- (c) Copy of CV
