

Twasa wa Lesedi FM o eletsa basadi ho hahamalla pele

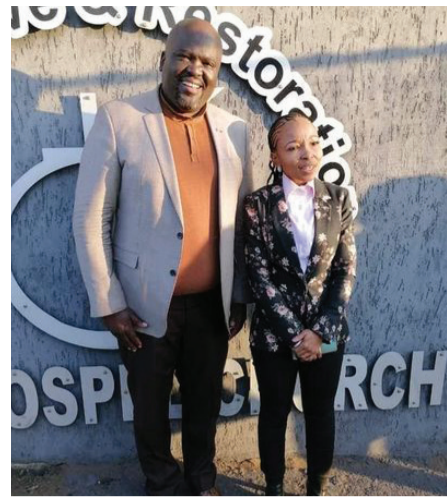

O eleditse tjena nakong eo e neng e le moreri tshebeletsong e ikgethileng ya letsatsi la basadi e neng e tshwaretse kerekeng ya City of Love and Restoration Full Gospel Church e Zamdela Sasolburg tlasa botsamaisi ba Moruti Thabiso Mashiloane.

“Jwaloka mosadi ha o hloke monna hore o be le ntlu, koloi kapa hore o tswelle bophelong” ho rialo Seoke. Sebui sa letsatsi e bile Letona mmusong wa profensi ya Free State Toto Makume o hlalositse ha a tla bua haholo ka bohlokwa ba bomme. “Bomme ba na le tshutsumetso ya pele baneng, ba na le tshutsumetso ya pele bokamosong ba bana hobane bokamoso bo matsohong a bana ka hoo re tlameha ho ananela bohlokwa ba bona kahare ho setjhaba sa rona” ho rialo Makume. Ho ya ka Makume, nakong ya kगतello ha balwanedi ba ntwala ba baleha naheng ba bolawa

ba bile ba kwallwa ditjhankaneng e bile bomme ba ileng ba e hlanaka ba beselletsa mollo wa tokoloho hore o se time. “Sesotho se re ‘Mosadi o tshwara thipa ka bohalleng’ mme mantswa a jwalo a ne a ke ke a tswa fela e bang ba ne ba se sebete, ba sena le tlhokomelo le boikarabelo. Ke lakatsa ho kgothatsa le ho tiisa bomme ka lentse le tswang bukeng e halalelang ho Baroma 5:3-5, e buang ka tshepo. Buka ena e bua ka hore mamello e aha sebopelo, sebopelo se aha tshepo” ho eketsa Makume. Motshwaruwa wa mehlang, Lerato Manaka o nkile sebaka le ena ho bua ka tsa bophelo ba hae, e le tsela ya ho boela a eletsa batjha.

“Ke ile ka hola ke na le tshabo ya ho ha nwa, batswadi ba ka ba ile ba nnyahlatsa ka kena Univesiting ya Johannesburg moo ke ile ka kopana le metswalle e mengata re sa eletsane ka tse mpe tseo re di etsang” ho rialo Manaka.

sebaka sa ho dula pelong ya hae. “Ke ne ke na le kgopolo ya hore re tla ba na le kutlwano e tebileng jwalo ka ntate le moradi, ntate a be teng mohla lenyalo laka, empa ha ho a ka ha eba jwalo” ho rialo Manaka. “Ka nako eo ke ne ke le ngwana, ke le nnotshi toropong tse kgolo kwana ke hloka le motho eo nka buang le yena, ke moo ha mmoho le metswalle re qadileng ho tsuba, ho nwa jwala, ho tsamaya meketjana, le ho kena dikamanong tsa lerato le batho ba bangata, hore re lebale mathata a rona a bophelo. Ke ile ka ba hlonofofatswa ka mosebetsi o motle wa ho ba hloho ya Diakhaonto (Head of Accountant) ho e nngwe ya di khampani tse kgolo, mme maemo ao a etsa hore ke fihlelle tjeleteng ya mongaka. “Ka ba ka la mathata ao ke neng ke

tobane le ona ka iphumane ke utswa tjeletele akhaonteng ya mongaka mme qetellong ka tshwarwa ke le dilemo tse 29, ke na le bana ba bararo. Ka fellwa ke mosebetsi ka lahlelwa tjhankaneng dilemo tse 12, dilemo tse nne di ile tsa fanyehwa mme ka sala ka tse robedi” ho eketsa Manaka.

“Batho ba bomme ne ke le bolella taba ena ya ka hore le kgone ho utlwisisa hore diqeto tseo re di etsang di lebisa hokae” ho rialo Manaka. Moruti Thabiso Mashiloane o lakaeditse bomme tse ntle fela ha ba keteka letsatsi le kgwedi ena ya bona. “Ke itse re be ba pele ho keteka letsatsi lena la bomme, re leboha tshutsumetso ya bomme setjhabeng sa rona” ho rialo Mashiloane. An emotional and overwhelmed Joubert who hails from Tshwane said she was truly humbled and grateful to win the title and to be the first to wear the glittering new Mowana (“Tree of Life”) crown from Nungu Diamonds. In her acceptance speech Joubert, a firm favourite among the crowd watching the pageant, said she is incredibly honoured and humbled to be crowned Miss South Africa 2023. “As I step into this new role, I am filled with a sense of responsibility to make a positive difference in the world around me. I believe that success is not just about personal

accomplishments, but about the opportunities, we have to give back and uplift those around us.

I will strive to be a source of inspiration and support for others, just as I have been supported on my journey now and before.

“This moment is the epitome of a full circle moment for me. A dream that started 11 years ago...I pledge to use this platform to advocate for the causes close to my heart and to be a source of inspiration for others. The new Miss South Africa received R1 million in cash in a prize and sponsorship package that includes the use of a serviced apartment at the lavish Brookfield at Royal in Kensington – developed by Tricolt – for the year of her reign.

She will also get to drive a Mercedes-Benz GLC as well as go on a trip to Paris sponsored by L’Oreal.
